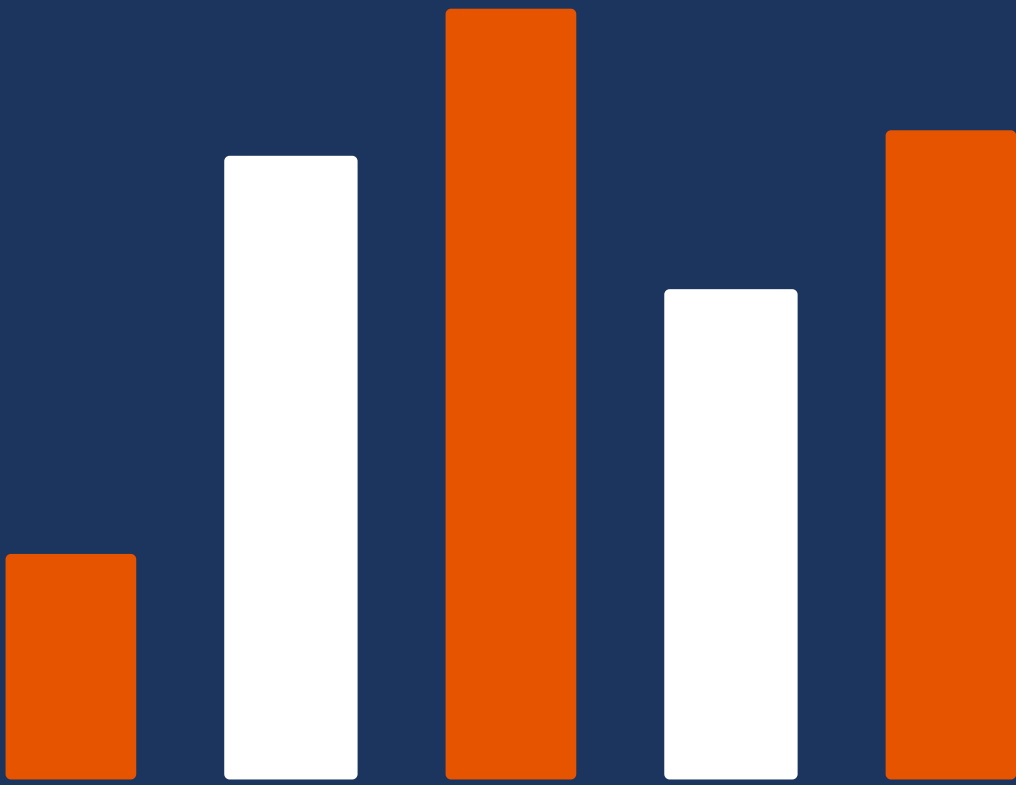

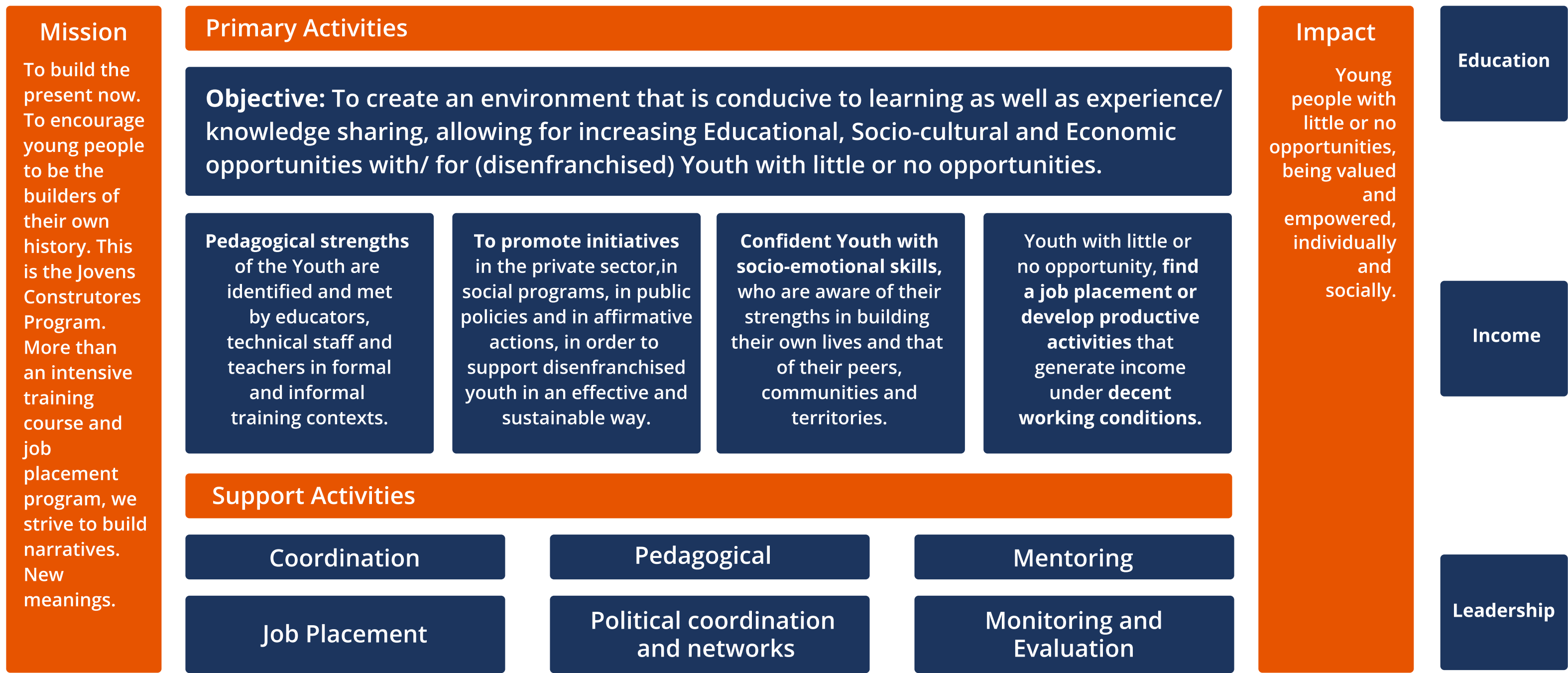
Jovens Construtores Program

The Jovens Construtores Program - JCP is a development program that uses its own social technology to promote capacity building of youngsters and adolescents. Originally conceived by YouthBuild, it was implemented in Brazil by CEDAPS, with the support of YouthBuild International.

From research to practice - the methodology's contribution to formal education:

Since 2019, CEDAPS has been conducting a number of studies with reputable partners to enable the contribution of the Jovens Construtores Program methodology to formal education. This has already been done in two other countries that are also part of the International YouthBuild network: the United States and Mexico. The most recent of these studies, "Jovens Construtores Program and the Education Eco-system" in partnership with PORVIR, was published in our last report.

We are now moving into the practical phase, in partnership with the Youth and Adult Education Department of the Municipal Secretariat of Education, in Rio de Janeiro. During the second semester, we will work at the Reference Center for Youth and Adult Education (CREJA), where we will be offering a professional qualification course after the school shift: together we will develop a training course based on the principles of the Program for teachers and others interested in learning about the JCP. In December, we will be back to tell you all about this new endeavor!

One-time projects with a purpose

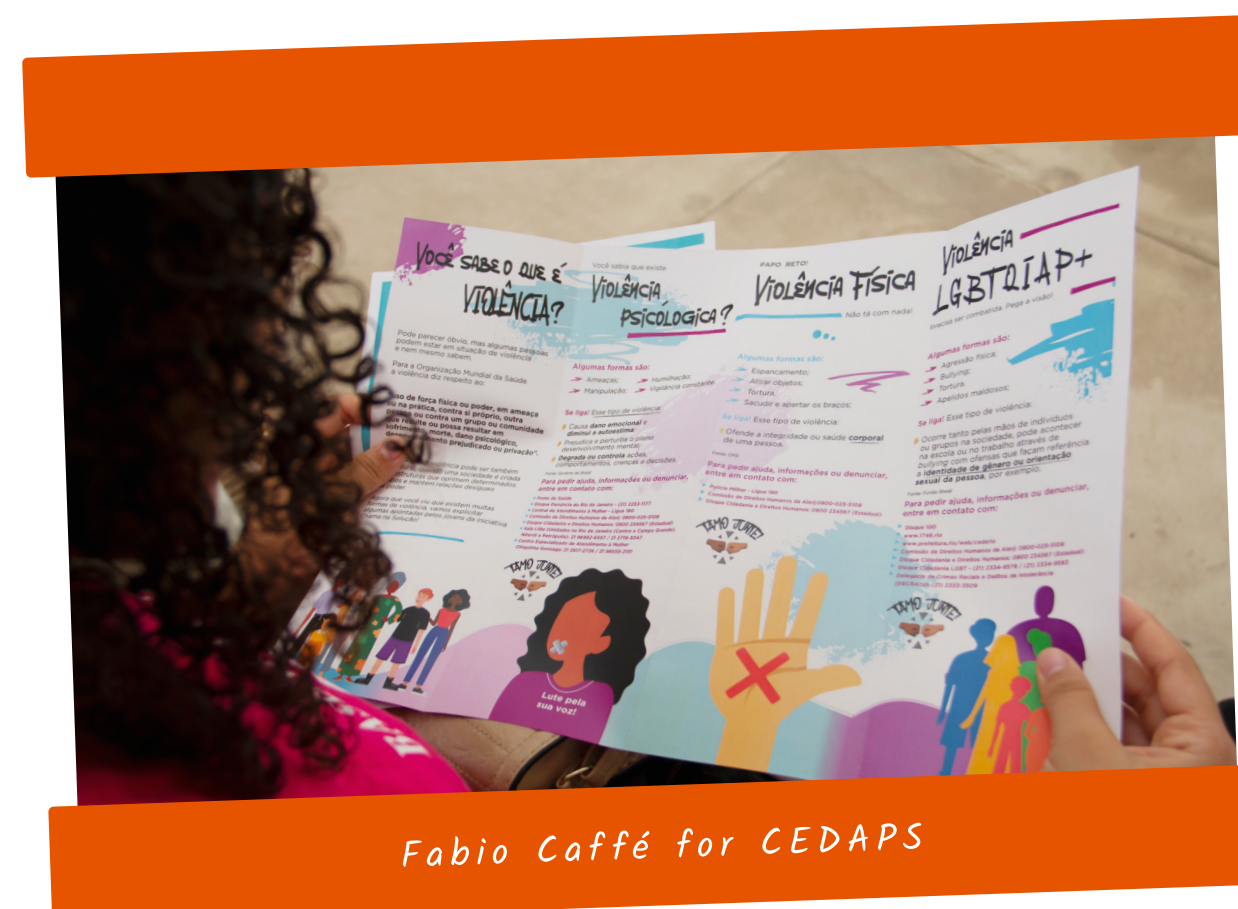
In addition to capacity building and professional qualification courses, the JCP also works on short-term initiatives that meet the objectives of the Program and, more specifically, of the youth to whom we are committed. During the first half of this year, some initiatives were carried out:

Chama na Solução - Rio de Janeiro 2022

Rio de Janeiro 2022: in partnership with UNICEF, we held the second edition of this initiative, this time with 50 teenagers and youth from Rio de Janeiro (mostly from the neighborhoods of Pavuna and Complexo da Maré) who devised ways of preventing different forms of violence.

Em in partnership with Americares, we are active in three locations in Rio de Janeiro: Morro dos Prazeres, Cidade de Deus, and Complexo do Alemão, with the goal of increasing the number of children vaccinated against Covid-19, through community actions carried out by young health promoters, in partnership with Primary Health Units and Community Based Organizations: ASVI (Cidade de Deus), Grupo PROA (Morro dos Prazeres), EDUCAP, and Compartilha Conhecimento (Complexo do Alemão).

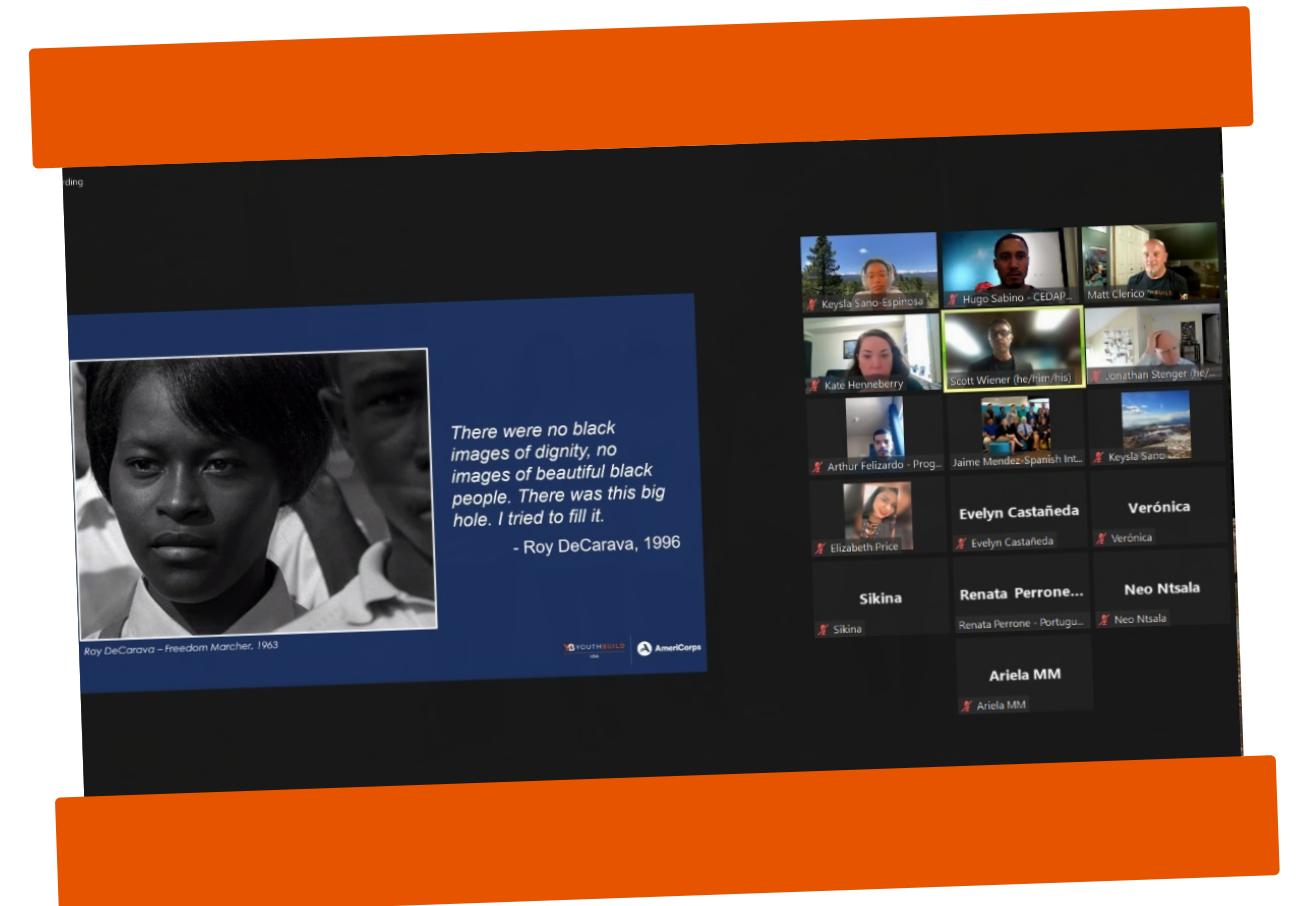


Actions with the YouthBuild International Network
